## How we spent last year's allocation

- Baseline testing in the Core to identify areas of concern and allow for targeted intervention
- Use of Lexia
- Use of the maths programme MyMaths to monitor and target support
- Targeted support during Lockdown 1 TA Google Classrooms, many Y7s invited to join KW/V provision
- Proactive staffing to weaker ability groups in KS3
- Year 7 mentoring programme some students given extended support to ensure truly settled into the year
- Focus on Y7 attendance and building good habits
- Re-Vamped transition process to ensure detailed information about GAPS and maths/English project to ensure standards not dropped over the summer break
