

Lessons should contain live content as much as possible. Live content can include:

Full online lesson: students will work with the teacher on Google Meets for around 50mins. Lessons will include teacher input and student working time.

Low Stakes Quizzes: the class take part in a short quiz which can be self-marked or answers are provided straight after.

Lessons should be 50 minutes to allow for a screen break between each lesson

Explain: Teachers will do an introduction whereby they explain key content and expectations and students then work independently with the teacher available in the chat.



Bespoke: this might include small group teaching, 1:1 support from TA or through external tutors or specialist adaptation by departments.

External Lesson: Teachers may integrate lessons from external sources (e.g. Oak Academy) with pause points for checking of understanding

Live feedback: work is set on Google Classroom (or other subject specific platform) and the teacher can see work being completed and provide feedback.

Q&A: students are set work to complete and the teacher asks questions / provides answers periodically through the lesson. Teacher able to respond to misconceptions directly to students through the Chat function

Video: teachers prepare a recorded lesson to present information and instructions with dedicate time for students to pause and complete activities

Students should expect to submit something to their teacher EVERY lesson.
