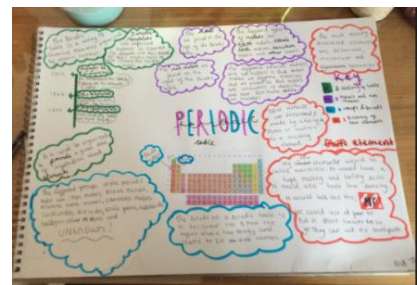
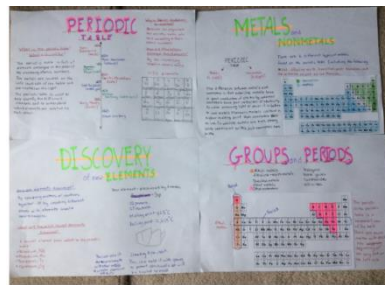
THIS WEEKS' SCIENCE SUPERSTARS!
