I just wanted to clarify our arrangements for testing over the next few days.

### Return to school testing opportunities – a summary

In order to conduct the return to school testing as efficiently and safely as possible we have provided multiple occasions that students can attend to have their return to school test completed. These have been explained in the communications from school on Tuesday 2 March. Please see a brief summary table below. You should refer to the school communication which provides specific details for each of the sessions.

A reminder that a student may not undergo testing unless we have full consent in advance. Please refer to the communication from school for the link to complete this.


