Creative Futures is an exciting series of free virtual workshops, which will give your Y9-11 students an indepth look into careers available within the creative industries. Commencing on **Wednesday 24 March 2021**, the session will run once a week at 5pm, outside of school hours.

The workshops will cover **Film Studies, Media Makeup, Journalism, Graphic Design and Theatre Performance**. We have teamed with partners including BBC Young Reporter, Bristol Old Vic Theatre School, Access Creative College, New College Swindon and Cirencester College, to ensure all the workshops are both engaging and informative!

Ideally, students will sign up for the whole series, to explore both avenues they are already interested in, and those they may not have considered. However, if they cannot attend some sessions due to clashes, they are still welcome to take part.

- 1. Register their interest on our <u>Creative Futures online application form</u> (which can also be found on the website). The deadline is Sunday 14 March 2021 (*Please note that spaces are limited, so completing the form doesn't guarantee a place on the programme*)
- 2. Owing to the age of participants, parent/carer permission will also be required. If we're able to offer students a place, we'll email them after the deadline to let them know that their place on the programme is being reserved. We'll then provide another form to be completed by their parent/carer by the deadline of Sunday 14 March 2021.
- 3. Once we've received both forms and their space is confirmed, we will email students each week with details of how to log on to that week's workshop
