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Dear Parent/Guardian

Now we are back in school I'd like to send you a quick reminder on our sanctions systems in school.

Same Day Sanctions

Each day there is a short 15-minute detention with a member of SLT at breaktime. This is given for uniform issues, Tools for Learning omissions, PE kit issues, lateness to lessons etc. This is generally well attended- for example on Friday 19th March all 11 students given this sanction attended. In addition, if there is a behaviour issue in a lesson or homework is missed, a student could also be asked to attend a departmental appointment so that they can complete a piece of work, be reminded about homework or meet the teacher to discuss a behaviour issue.

After School Sanctions

If any of the shorter sanctions are missed without a valid reason, students are then given an after-school detention on a Thursday until 4pm. Parents will be notified by e-mail on a Tuesday afternoon and the students will be given a physical detention slip on Wednesday. If, for any reason, attendance on this particular evening proves impossible please notify the school in good time and we will rearrange it for a different evening. Whilst I understand the Thursday after school detention can cause a degree of inconvenience attending the initial short detention in the first instance should stop the students from having to attend the after-school detention.

I'm sure you will agree that the school is prospering as a result of clear behaviour systems and students understanding that there is a consequence if they fall short of our expectations. Uniform looks smart, almost all students have complete sets of equipment, a greater percentage of homework is being completed and lessons run much more smoothly because of the strong conduct of the students. As a result, students are making more progress and their attainment is constantly improving which is one of our key goals in running the school.
