

Year 10 PPEs (Mock Exams), June 2021

Year 10 PPEs will take place between 14th and 18th June. Please see next page for the timetable. The exams will all take place during the normal school day, including for students who have extra time. Lunch will be at 12.35pm as usual. Students have already had an assembly about these exams and they will be given their own paper copy of this timetable. Individual subject teachers will inform students of topics for revision and any subject specific requirements.

Students who do Photography or Art will have an extended exam on the 11 June or 29 June. Mr Watterson will share the details closer to the time.

Exam Rules

The PPEs are run in exactly the same way as formal exams so your child should be aware of the JCQ rules, which can be found [here](#) on our website. Failure to follow these rules could lead to disqualification from their overall qualification.

The main points have been highlighted below:

- Normal school uniform must be worn – no gloves, scarves, hats, hoodies or coats will be allowed.
- Bags should be left in the designated area outside the exam room.
- All necessary equipment should be in a clear pencil case/clear food bag. Calculator covers and unnecessary stationery should be left in bags.
- Water is allowed in clear bottles but any labels must be removed.
- Phones should be turned off and left in bags.
- Students will be asked to remove wrist watches and place them on the desk at the start of the exam. Smart watches are treated in the same way as mobile phones and need to be left in bags.
- Students must not communicate with any other candidate from the moment they enter the exam room until the time when they are asked to leave.
- Students must follow all instructions given to them by the invigilators.

Access Arrangements

Students who have previously agreed access arrangements will be shown where they will be sitting their exams on Friday 11th June. Invigilators will endeavour to start exams as promptly as possible so that students have the opportunity to use all of their extra time. It is vital that students use their access arrangements as the school must have evidence that these are the student's normal way of working in order to apply to the JCQ.
