GCSE Biology visit to Millennium Field – 7 July 2021

Your son/daughter will have the opportunity to take part in an educational and enrichment trip to **Millennium Field in Sonning Common on 7 July 2021**.

As part of the GCSE Biology course, students are asked to complete a compulsory practical where students sample an area for biodiversity using Quadrats and Belt transects. The students will meet in the Quad on 7 July 2021 **at 8:45am** to register and for a prompt departure.

We will be walking from school to the Millennium Field, the route we will take is off road and does not take the students onto main roads. The walk will take approximately 30 minutes each way. We will return to school in time for the end of the day and students can return home is their usual way.

The dress code will be school uniform but please consider the potential weather conditions for the day. Students can wear trainers or walking boots regardless of weather. During hot weather your son/daughter will need to bring drinks and a sensible hat and sun cream. During wet weather appropriate clothing will be needed, this includes wellington boots/walking boots and a waterproof coat.

School rules will apply in regards to make up and jewellery. The students will **not** be allowed to use their mobile phones during the day except in case of emergency to ring the school's mobile phone held by one of the staff. Once again the advice is not to bring expensive equipment e.g. MP3 players, as the safety of the items cannot be guaranteed. Also they will not be covered by the school's insurance policy.

Students need to bring a picnic lunch, if your student is in receipt of Free School Meals a picnic will be provided for them to take in the morning. If the weather is appropriate the science department will offer an ice cream to each student participating in the trip free of charge.
