I hope you are well and keeping safe. With over 80% of parents signed up for next Wednesday this suggests that this style of parents' evening is very popular indeed. Overall, I have to say I am very pleased with Year 11 and their attitude to school this year and many of the mock results I have seen reflect this. Who knows what next summer may bring but the students are certainly giving themselves a good chance of success based on their current levels of application.

We had a lovely breaktime on Tuesday with the Key Stage 3 Busking Lunch. Performances from Vakaris, Jimmy and Emily all lit up our morning. These students are my **Students of the Week** for their courage and confidence in performing. As someone once said "Life begins at the end of your comfort zone". The event was well attended in a socially distanced manner and a big thank you to Miss Fay for her organisation in making this happen in these strained times.

Please find below our new Student and Parent Bulletin. I want to make sure that all parents know as much as possible about the events and clubs going on in school and therefore can encourage student participation. For example, our Magistrates Competition group launches next week. This is a brilliant opportunity for any student who enjoys debate, quick thinking, current affairs and crime! Alongside this our lunchtime dance club is back on from next week and in both instances, parents nudging children can make a difference to participation and helping to get bags packed correctly for the next day.


