Emergency Contacts on Mobile Phones ... Did You Know ...

You probably know that even when your phone is locked there is an option to make an emergency call.

What you might not know, is that this also serves as an ICE (In Case of Emergency) feature; you can programme in the names and numbers of people you would want to be contacted if you are found injured or incapacitated. It also allows you to store your medical information.

iPhone: Settings > Emergency SOS > Set up emergency contacts in health

Android: Varies between phones > Press Emergency call with phone locked > brings screen up and you can add emergency contact details and any other medical notes/conditions.
