Science - Year 10

I am very pleased with current progress in Science from Year 10. Recognising this progress during a difficult time is important and I congratulate all of Year 10 on their hard work. However, building on this progress is important and I also do not want to lose the momentum Year 10 have built up in recent months.

This year in Science we have a motto "Practice to perfect" and with that in mind students are being given Christmas homework to complete and bring back to school. Given that students are either studying for 2 GCSEs or 3 GCSEs in Science, the amount of homework reflects this. I recommend students spend a full hour of work (60 minutes) on each subject, so if they are currently studying for 3 GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics they have been given 3 hours of work to do. Students can use their knowledge organisers to help them with this homework.
