### Y10 Revision

Following the Easter holidays students in Year 10 will sit a first round of formal PPEs in each of their GCSE subjects, with the exception of BTEC Sport (*where the external exam is taking place on Thursday 28 April*). The PPEs will be conducted between **9 – 13 May**. Key information about sitting formal exams and a timetable will be published directly after the Easter break.

This first round of PPEs are an opportunity for students to experience sitting exams in the Main Hall or Training Suite and to experience the demands of sitting multiple papers in a given day. Students who have previously agreed Access Arrangements will conduct the exams with these in place. To support students in their preparation for these exams they will be completing sessions within PHSE & tutor time on successful techniques for revision. Additionally, we will be running after school revision sessions starting on Tuesday 26 April for each subject in the run up to the exams.

The revision sessions will focus on recapping key pieces of knowledge as well as helping students ensure they are able to secure the most marks in a question by re-visiting key techniques in responding to different types of exam question. Each exam paper will be an hour long and will include questions from topics studied across the course of Y10 so far.
