### Homework & Bromcom

Following our move to Bromcom during the Spring term we have now completed our transition to the platform for the setting of homework too. This replaces Show My Homework (SMHW) which has now been deactivated.

In the final week of last term students were given information and support to activate the Bromcom Student App (or shown how to log onto the web-based platform). This allows students to track their House Points and Behaviour Points, view their timetable and now see any homework that has been set and the deadline for completion. Students have been introduced to the functionality of the homework widget through tutor time this week. There are also some short 'how to guides' that have been added to tutor Google Classrooms.

As with SMHW parents are also able to view homework assignments that have been set – this can be viewed on the My Child at School (MCAS) app.

Homework continues to be an area of focus for the school and we appreciate all your support in ensuring that students engage positively with homework to further their learning and progress.

The final part of the Bromcom rollout this academic year will be the assessment widget which will allow you to see your child's tracking report. This will be completed in conjunction with the calendared reporting cycle and we will provide any additional information with the release of the report.
