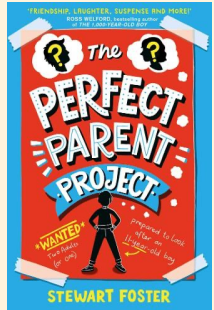
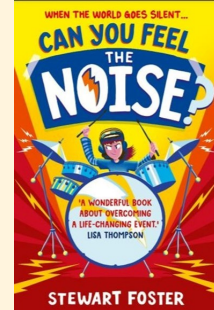
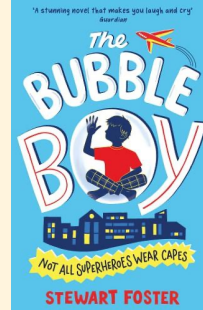
STEWART FOSTER

Each book is filled with emotion, adventure and drama, making them an exciting read while still ensuring you care about the characters, too!

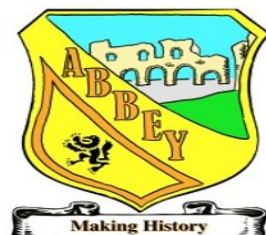


If you like Lisa Thompson or Ross Welford, you'll love these books!
