CHRISTOPHER EDGE

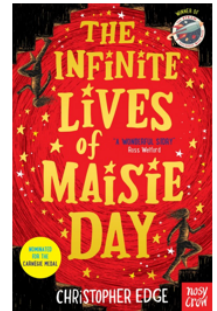


Four of Christopher's books have been nominated for the prestigious CLIP Carnegie medal.

## Reading Ambassadors

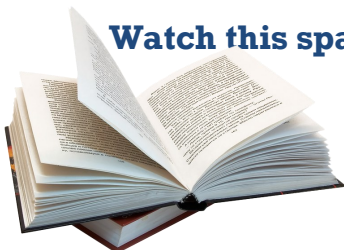
A select few of KS3/KS4 students have been working hard to promote reading, school wide.

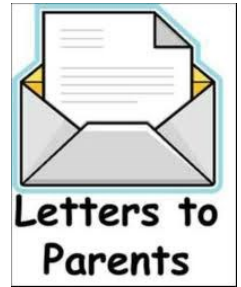
