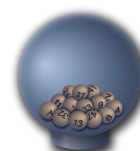

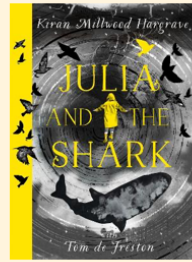

Kiran has been writing for a number of years and in 2019 her debut children's book was published...and won an award! Although most of her books have been published for children, she does also write for adults and young adults, too!

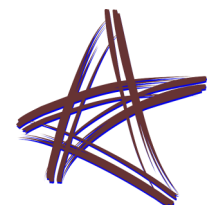
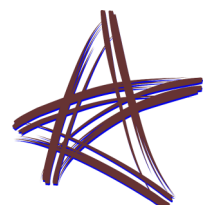
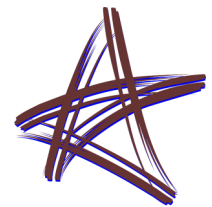
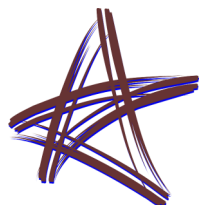
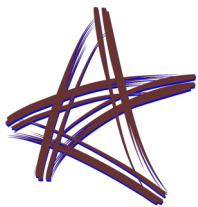
Her most recent books have been created with her husband, Tom, who is an illustrator. They have beautiful pictures to go with a beautifully told story.

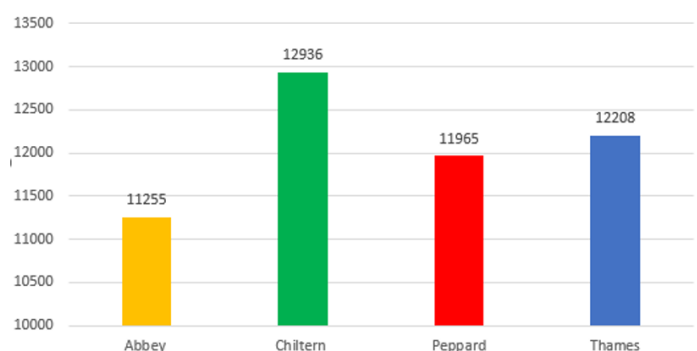

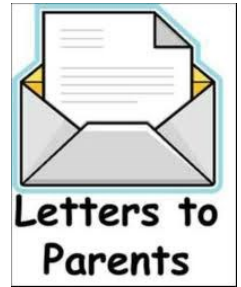
