Staffing at Maiden Erlegh Chiltern Edge

I am writing to confirm some staffing changes at MECE.

After half term I will be working on a project for the Trust each Friday. I have rearranged my duties and meetings to fit around this four-day schedule so nothing will be compromised as a result. In my absence on Fridays, our current Deputy Headteacher, Miss Bliss, will be the acting Headteacher.

In addition, after February half-term, Miss Bliss will be working at Maiden Erlegh Reading on Monday and Tuesday. This is to provide MER with some capacity as their senior leadership team develops more experience, along with supporting some staffing challenges that they are currently facing. Emma will provide her abundant expertise and energy to support them over the next couple of terms.

To provide MECE with capacity to cover these two adjustments we have appointed two of our middle leaders into Assistant Headteacher roles. Therefore, I am both delighted and proud, that Miss Cheeseman and Mr Hunter will be joining our senior leadership team for the rest of the year.
