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### Inclusion Bulletin - Autumn 2018

#### Attendance:

We are pleased to say that the overall attendance of pupils at the school is 95% for the year so far. This is an improvement on previous years. A total of 149 pupils have achieved 100% for the term and just under 90% of our pupils have an attendance of 90% or higher.

We are now running Reward Activities each term for pupils with attendance which matches the government's expectations for attendance and who have demonstrated positive behaviour and an excellent attitude to learning throughout the term.



We encourage pupils to attend school on time, every day. Please ensure your child is always in school for the 8.40 start.

If a pupil has 19 days of absence each year (90% attendance), over their time in education they would miss the equivalent of 1 year of education and this dramatically reduces their chance of success at their GCSEs.

If your child needs a medical or dental appointment we encourage you to arrange this outside of the school day and will not authorise holidays during the term.

If your child is absent from school you must contact the school by 9am to inform us of this and giving a reason for the absence. Your child should only be absent from school in cases of serious illness. We have a new system this year where the Attendance, Behaviour and Welfare Officers comes out to pupils houses when we are concerned about their absence.

If your child's attendance drops below 90% we will contact you and may invite you in to school for a meeting to discuss how we can work together to improve on this. If it remains low we will refer you to the County Attendance Officers to formalise this process. Already several pupils this year have been referred to the County Attendance Officer.

### **SEND:**

We have also been reviewing the SEND register in school and looking at ways to develop it, so the right pupils are targeted with the best suited support. The Inclusion Team are now having regular meetings to review the register and the provision of the most at need pupils.

Lexia is still a very valuable tool in developing our pupil's literacy in a fun and interactive manner. Owen T is the Lexia star for Year 7 this term. 20 pupils in Year 7 have been invited to use this program and we have active licences for 65 pupil across the school. If your child has a Lexia licence available to them it is really important they use this program as often as possible.

Each Term we hold a Celebration Assembly and pupils receive nominations and rewards for different subject areas. We also have a nomination for the best pupil in a Key Stage, this term winner is:

Joseph C, 9B – Key Stage 3
