

For example, if a child comes in at break and buys just a cookie there will not be enough allowance left at lunchtime for a drink and a sandwich or a hot meal.

Don't forget we also have **Breakfast Club open to everyone** from 8:20 every morning. There is an **additional £1.50** allowance for all students that qualify for Free School Meals to use at Breakfast Club every day.
