Year 11 PPEs (Mocks) 2023

Year 11 PPEs this year will take place between 31 October and 8 November. Exams will all take place during the normal school day, including for students who have extra time.

Exam Rules

The PPEs are run in the same way as the formal exams in the summer so students should be aware of the JCQ rules, which are on our website (under Students, Examinations, Information for Candidates). Failure to follow these rules could lead to disgualification.

Bags should be left in the designated area outside the exam room.

Phones, watches, AirPods, earphones/earbuds and iPods are not allowed in the exam room. All such electronic items must be turned off and left in student bags (outside the exam room).

Only necessary equipment (2 black pens, a pencil, rubber, ruler, protractor and compass) should be brought into the exam room, and this should be in a clear pencil case/food bag. Do not bring any unnecessary items in with you like glue sticks or tissues. If you need a calculator, you should bring your own and you should leave the cover in your bag.

Water is allowed in **clear** plastic bottles with any labels removed, no other food or drinks are allowed.

Normal school uniform must be worn - no gloves, scarves, hats, hoodies or coats will be allowed.

Students must not communicate in any way with any other candidate from the moment they enter the exam room until they leave.

The exam paper should not be written on or opened until the invigilators have given a clear instruction to do so, this includes filling in the details on the front cover.

Students must follow all instructions given to them by the invigilators.

Access Arrangements

Students who have previously agreed access arrangements will be told where they will be sitting. Invigilators will endeavour to start exams as promptly as possible so that students can use all their extra time. It is vital that students use their access arrangements as the school must keep evidence that these are the student's normal way of working.
