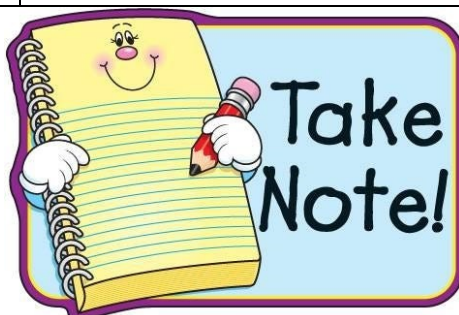

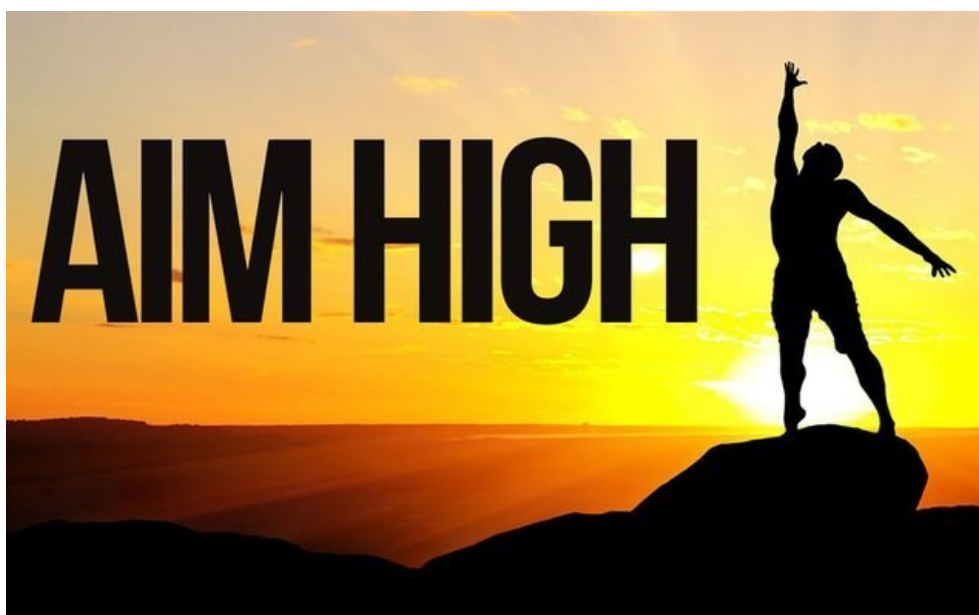
Mr Caldwell—Fundraising
