There is no guarantee of being accepted but should you be successful the charity will be in touch for delivery to your home address, (please be patient as this will be nearer to Christmas).



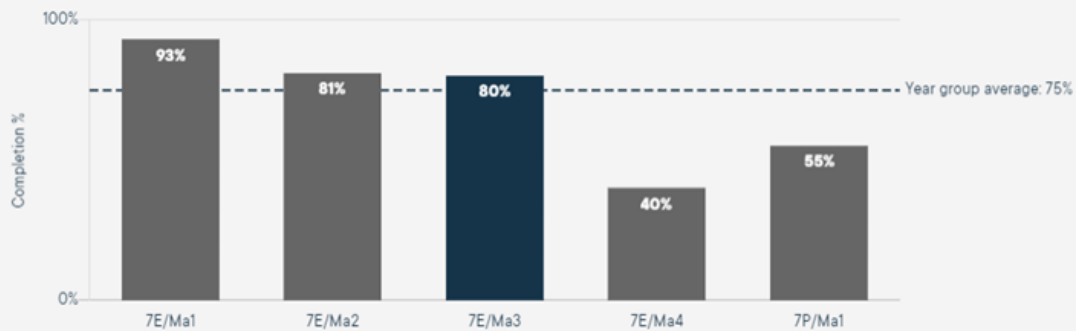

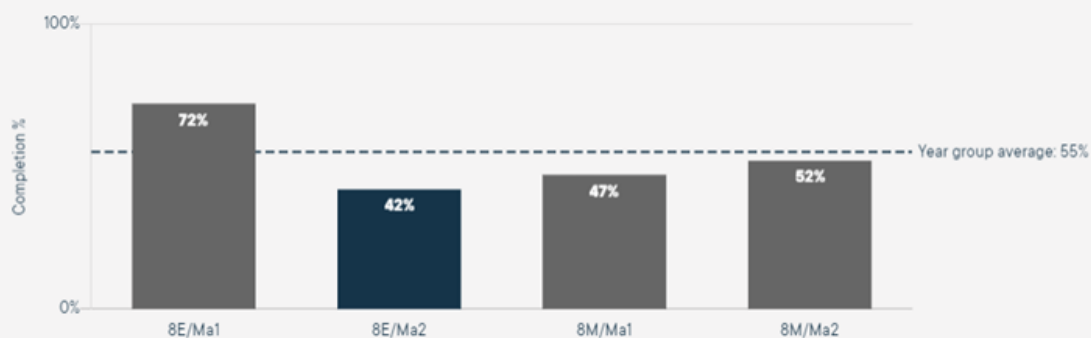

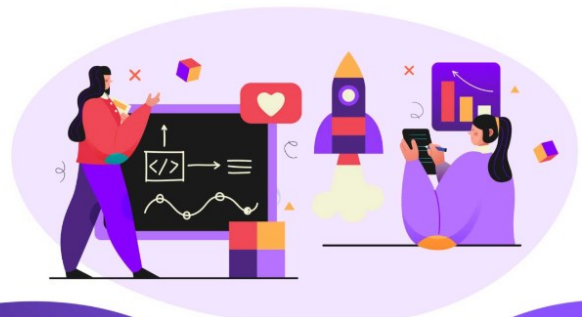
