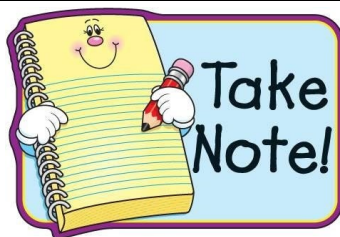

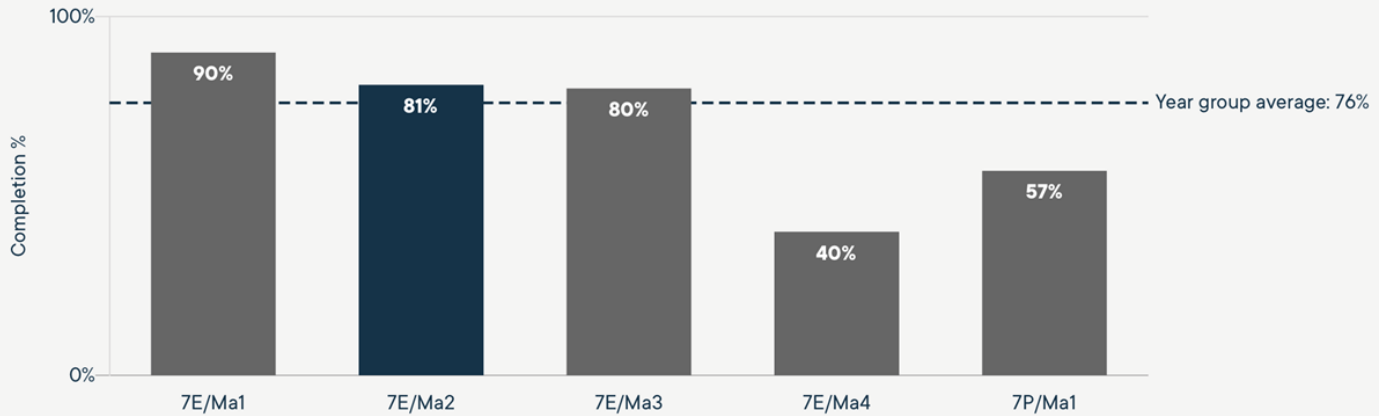

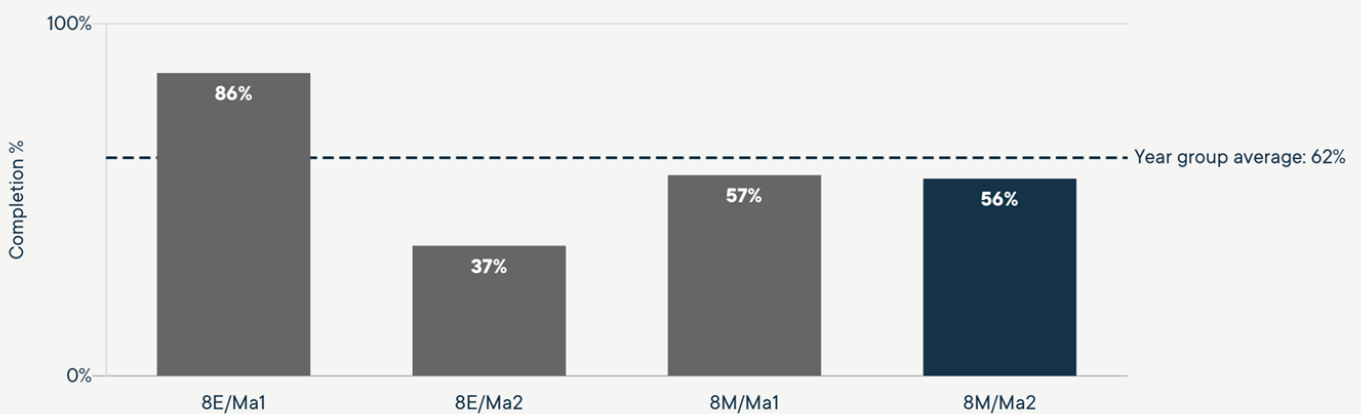

These students have not only completed their homework on time and handed it in but also obtained top marks in their homework in comparison to their peers. Well done !

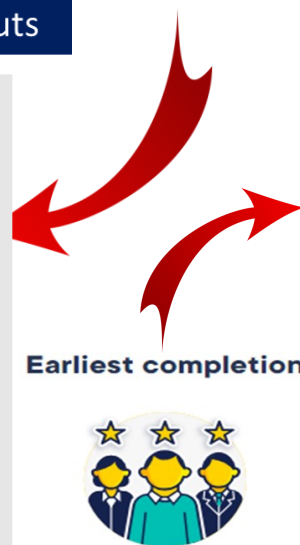
