Travel Logistics



We will be leaving school very early on the Friday and returning late on the Sunday.

We will be travelling by coach to Dover and then catching a ferry across the Channel to Calais. We will then be travelling by coach to Ypres.

We will be staying at a hostel in the center of Ypres.

We will be following an itinerary set by travel company *Diverse School Travel*.

How much will it cost?



The total cost will be £333. This is based off 50 students attending. We are hopeful that this will be a full trip but **if less students attend then the cost will increase**.

This will be broken up into installments across the next year with the first payment of £25 to be paid at the beginning of December.



How does my child get a place?

You will need to complete the expression of interest form by the deadline outlined on the trip letter.

In the instance that more than 50 people express interest, then we will draw the students out of a random ballot.

The 50 allocated a place will then be given further details.
