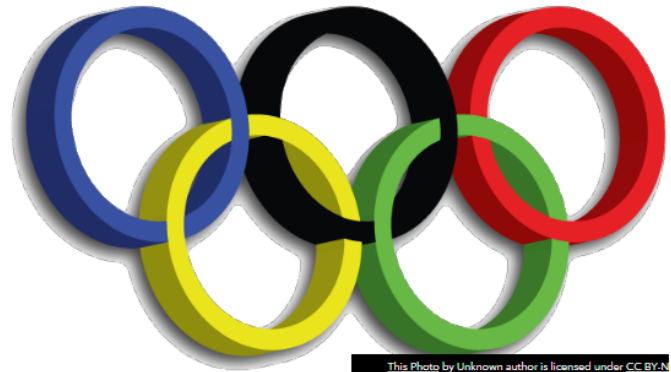

For the audition you will need to present the following:

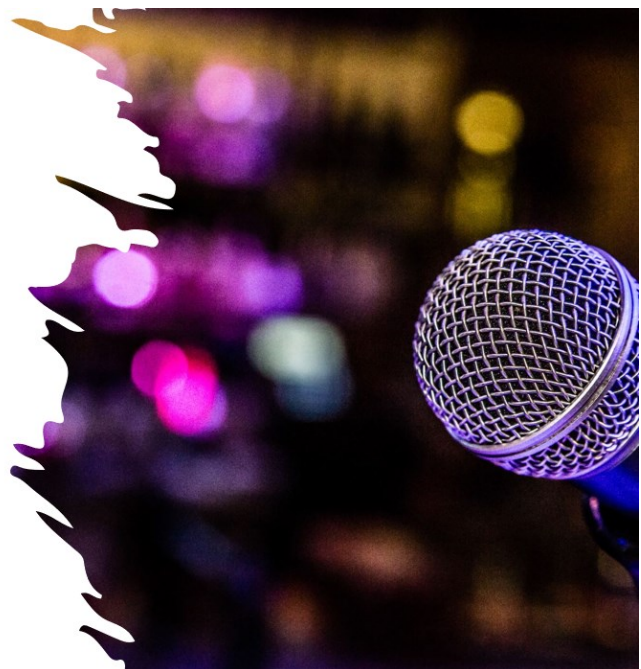

As in previous years, Mr Harte has some audition pieces for you to collect from him.




