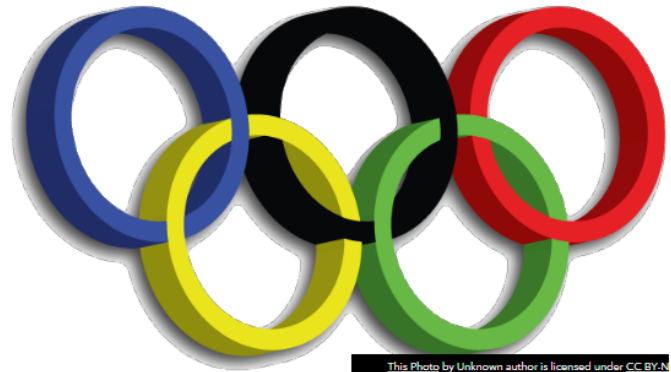

For the audition you will need to present the following:

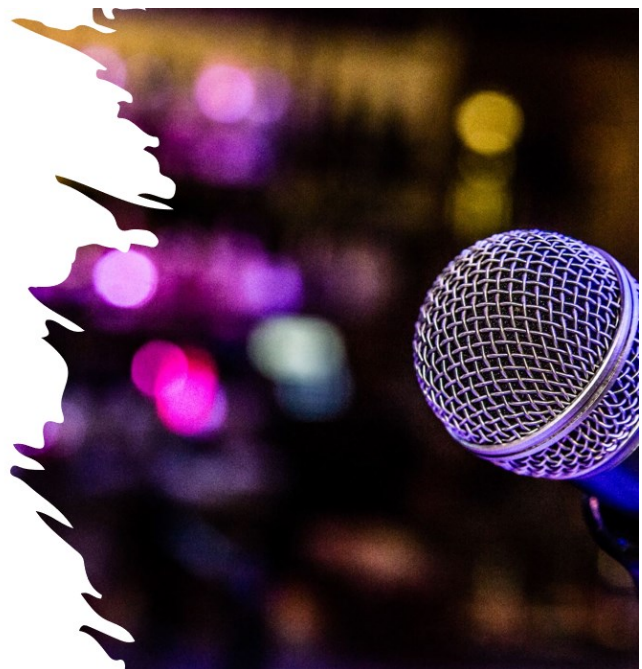
A monologue



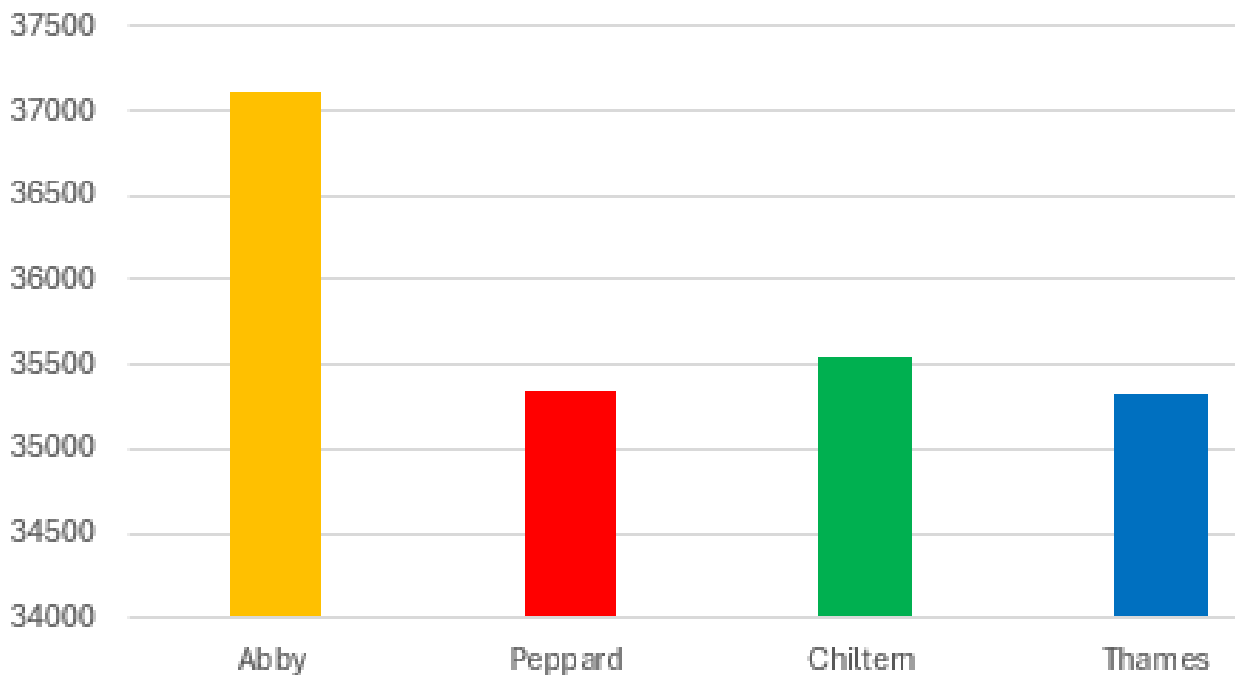

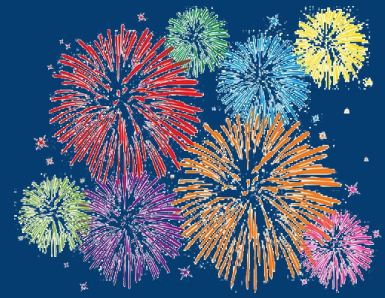

- Crime

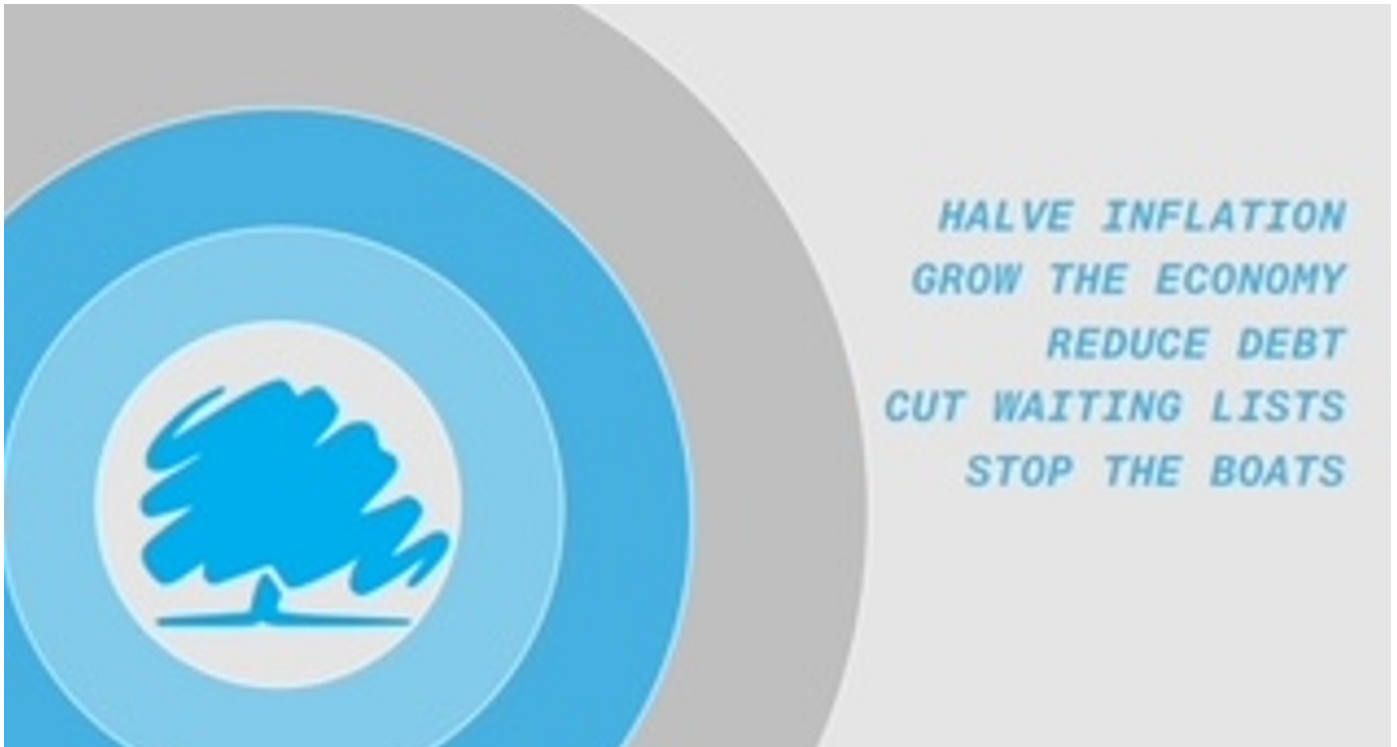
