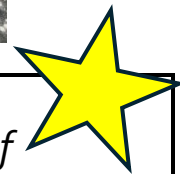


Food Technology – delicious desserts

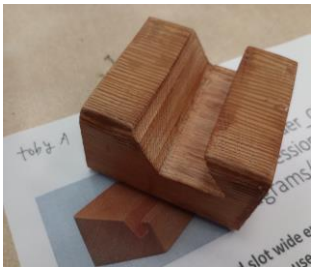
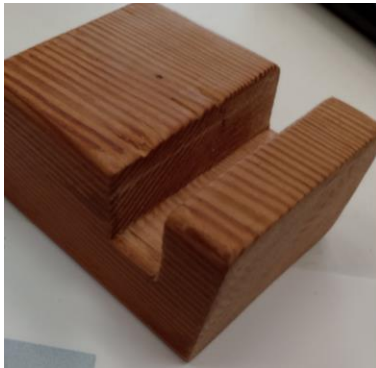
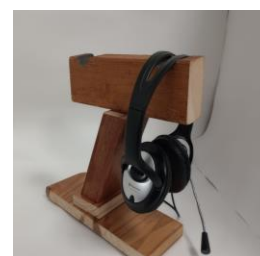


Y9 Taster Day: The upcoming Y9 students about to start their GCSE in Design Technology worked on chisel skills to produce a device holder – made from reclaimed material.

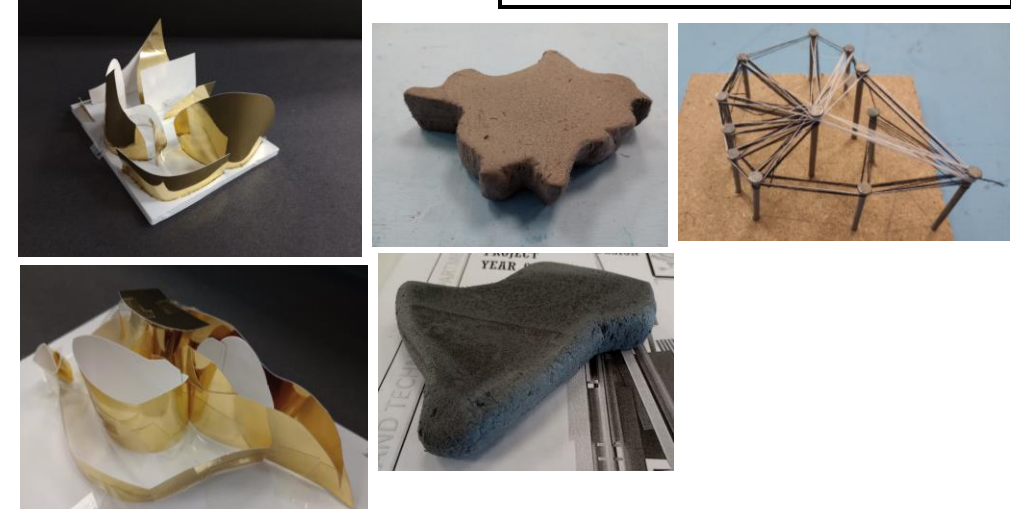
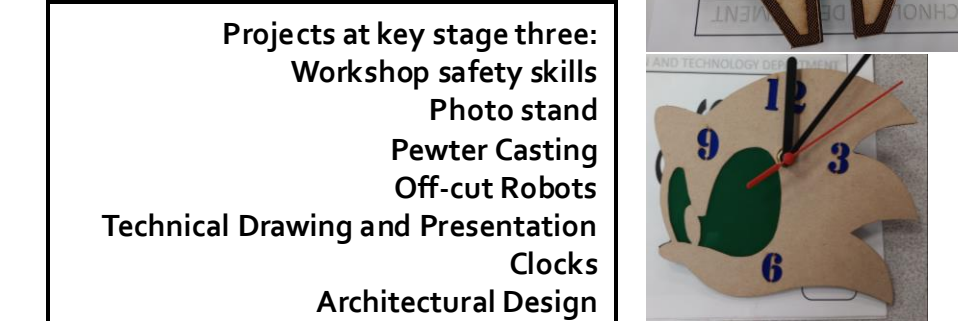
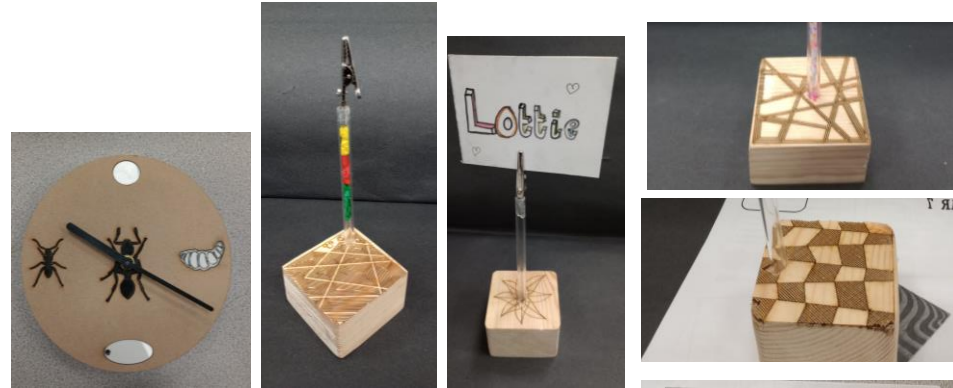
