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Dear Parent/Guardian

I hope that you and your family have had a good summer break and that you are getting ready for the return to school - staff were in school yesterday and today undertaking training and preparing for the return of students from Wednesday onwards.

The school site has been busy with improvement works over the holidays and I am pleased to report that the Maths department has received new coat of paint and new carpets and that two blocks of toilets have been fully refurbished. The students have repeatedly raised the quality of the toilets since I arrived at the school so I know that this change will be appreciated, and I hope that the new facilities will be looked after by all those who use them. The specific arrangements for each year group are listed below:

## Wednesday 4 September

Years 7 and 11 return to school

- Students will follow a **bespoke timetable** on this day which will be issued during tutor time (this **will not match** the timetable in the MCAS App).
- They **will not** need PE kit.
- All students will have lunch provided for them today – students can choose to bring their own lunch if they would prefer.
- Students may choose to access the canteen at break time to purchase snacks.
- Year 7 students should make their way to the Quad to meet their tutor at 8:40am.
- Year 11 students should make their way to their Tutor room at 8:40am.

## Thursday 5 September

All students in school

- Students will spend the morning in an extended tutor session. The timetable for the day will commence Period 2.
- Students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 11 should head to their tutor rooms at 8:40am.
- Year 10 should line up in the quad at 8:40am.



- The canteen will be open for students to use before school, at break and at lunch. **Year 7** will have early access at break and lunch.

For parents and students who have the MCAS / Bromcom App set up the new year timetable will go live in the App on **Tuesday**. Students will be issued a hard copy from their tutor on Weds / Thursday morning. Do also note that the numbers on any classes in core subjects no longer correspond to sets.
