Students living in Oxfordshire

Oxfordshire County Council:

Oxfordshire County Council may provide free transport (or meet the cost of travel) for your child if he/she meets the criteria described in the Council's Home to School Transport Policy. This is typically where a child attends their nearest school and lives over the statutory walking distance (which for secondary aged students is 3 miles). You should have been informed by the council's school admissions team if your child qualifies for free home to school travel. If you have any queries, please contact Oxfordshire County Council School Transport Eligibility Team by email – schooltransporteligibility@oxfordshire.gov.uk
