Subject teachers in English, Maths and Science have shared the revision topics with students via Class Charts and discussed in lessons this week the makeup of the papers. Please find a summary below:

Subject	Length of Paper	Number of Marks	Key Topics / structure
Maths	90m	80	Probabilities, Percentages, Ratios, Fractions, expressions (simplify and factorise), straight line graphs, Perimeters, Venn diagrams, inequalities, Nth terms, translations.
English	60m		English Language: Language Analysis and Creative Writing
Science x 3	45m (per paper)		Biology: Cell biology and transport, organisation, infection and response. Chemistry: Atomic structure and the periodic table, Bonding, structure and the properties of matter, energy changes in chemical reactions. Physics: Global and national energy resources, energy stores and transfers, electricity (in the home as well as parallel and series circuits). All science papers will skills related to working scientifically .
