Final GCSE Communication

As we approach the final handful of GCSE exams in the Summer 2025 series I wanted to send a last communication of key information and messages.

GCSE Results

GCSE results day this year will be on **21 August 2025** and we are planning to offer students two methods of collection for results this year:

1. Collection from school – Students who opt for this option will be able to collect their results in person from the school site, between 10.00am and 11.30am. **We will not release results to third parties under any other circumstances.**
2. Email – Students unable to attend results collection on the day can request they are emailed to them. This will take place **from 10am on 21 August** and a hard copy results letter will also be posted to the address we hold on file. These emails will be sent to the student's **school email address** unless the student has already sent a signed letter/email stating they wish an alternative address to be used (e.g. parent).

Prom – 26 June 2025

We are getting excited for the upcoming Prom taking place at Badgemore Golf Club (Henley-on-Thames) on 26 June 2025. Students are now able to collect their pre-paid ticket from Student Services – they will be asked to sign to say they have collected it.

Students should arrive from 6.30pm with entry to the venue from 7pm. There is a lovely big car park where parents and friends can wait and welcome Y11 students arriving. We keep our fingers crossed for a warm, sunny June evening.

The Prom is a school event and as such no students will not be allowed to enter with cigarettes or vapes. Alcohol and other illegal substances are also prohibited. Any student found with these items will be removed and parents will be called to pick them up.

Students should be collected by 11pm.

Yearbooks

Any students who have purchased a Yearbook will be able to collect their copy at the end of the Prom. If your child is not attending Prom, Yearbooks will be available to collect on GCSE Results Day instead.

Please can you ensure all lockers are cleared and left clean before your son/daughter's last day in school.

Uniform

Firstly, a small plea. Can you please remind your son/daughter that they must be in school uniform (as per exam regulations) for their remaining exams – there has been a little bit of slippage since Half Term. Please also remind students that when they are on the school site they must abide by other school rules, most notably mobile phone / headphone use. As Year 11s they remain role models to younger students and as such can expect to be challenged by staff if they are not meeting these expectations.

With the completion of the examinations almost upon us we know that many families might be in a position and willing to donate school uniform back to the school to be added to our “spares” that we lend to students. We also liaise with CESA who can sell pre-loved uniform to other MECE families. We are particularly keen for donations of blazers, PE Kit, skirts and trousers. If you would be willing to donate your son/daughter’s uniform then this can be dropped at school reception between 8am-4pm.

Revision Guides / Study Aids / Text Books

We also willingly accept copies of revision guides / text books and other study aids that may no longer be of use. These are often re-purposed within departments or the school library to support next year’s GCSE students. Again, these can be dropped into reception between 8am-4pm.

Post-16 Study / Apprenticeship

Any student who has not yet secured their place for Post-16 study or an Apprenticeship can still access support from school over the remainder of the school year. They should contact Ms Cheeseman in the first instance who can coordinate members of the team to help with applications. Where at all possible we encourage students to have both a first and second choice option in place ahead of results day. Should it be required there will be additional access to further support on GCSE Results day.
