### Lulworth Cove Trip – Monday 21 July 2025

Your son/daughter will have the opportunity to take part in an educational and enrichment trip to **visit Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door as part of our year 7 Coasts topic.**

All year 7 are invited on this trip.

*The day will consist of two halves:*

- *A short walk down to Lulworth Cove to undertake some Geographical Fieldwork Activities.*
- *A half hour hike to Durdle Door for further Geographical Fieldwork and their packed lunch on top of the cliff.*

*Students will also have the opportunity to visit the local shops in Lulworth for souvenirs or an ice-cream.*

The students will meet in the quad on **21st July at 8.45** to register and for a prompt departure.

In order to be able to run this trip, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£25** per student which is payable through **ParentPay**. This will cover the cost of the coach for the day. We may be able to provide financial assistance for those students who are registered for the Student Premium. Should the financial contribution create any problems, please contact me. **Please note that if there are insufficient contributions to cover the cost of this activity, there may be no alternative but to cancel.** *Payment should only be made if you agree with the conditions set out in the Parent Agreement below.*

- I also understand that it is my child's responsibility to make up for any missed class or homework and to do so at an appropriate standard. I will support them to do this.

If your child requires any medication e.g. an inhaler this must be brought on the trip or your child will not be allowed on the trip.

**Should your child's medical circumstances change, it is your duty to inform the school in writing as soon as possible and before the day of departure.**

We will travel by coach to Lulworth and participate in Geography Fieldwork. Students should bring a packed lunch and drink. **If your child usually has free school meals one will be provided on the day.** The dress code will be **MECE PE kit and sensible footwear**; please consider the potential weather conditions for the day. During hot weather your son/daughter will need to bring a drink for the bus and a sensible hat and sun cream. During wet weather appropriate clothing will be needed. School rules will apply in regard to make up and jewellery. The students will **not** be allowed to use their mobile phones during the day except in case of emergency to ring the school's mobile phone held by one of the staff. Once again, the advice is not to bring expensive equipment e.g. MP3 players, as the safety of the items cannot be guaranteed. Also, they will not be covered by the school's insurance policy.

There will be time where your son/daughter will be allowed to visit the local shops. This will mean that they will be remotely supervised by the accompanying staff. We will issue them with a mobile phone number, a map and require them to report to a rendezvous point.

We will return to Maiden Erlegh Chiltern Edge at around **5.30pm** should this be any later, we will ask the students to contact you by phone.

***Please note that representing the school on a trip, fixture or at an event is a privilege and we reserve the right to withdraw that privilege for students who are persistently late to school or lessons, do not follow our uniform or behaviour policies or bring the school into disrepute in any way.***
