What do the results mean?

You have received a % score for each of the exams you sat.

You have also been given the AVERAGE % score for YOUR CLASS in each subject. This allows you get a sense of how you performed compared to your peers

These scores DO NOT equate to GCSE grades... you have only studied (and were assessed) on a very small amount of the content so it is not possible to give an indication of GCSE grades....

For MOST people, their Maths score is higher than their Science - this is because of how the papers were constructed

In Maths, there will be an opportunity in class before the end of term to attempt a paper that includes Higher content, for students who scored over 70%
