Year 11 core PPEs

Yesterday we held an assembly with Year 11 to share the [Core PPE timetable - see here](#). These will be held 9-13 February. Please note that students who have Work Experience or College as part of their weekly provision should still attend work experience/college during the PPE week and we will organise for them to sit missed exams at another time.

Summer examination entries

During the assembly students were asked to check their exam entries and sign to say they are correct. They were then issued with a copy of their timetable for the May/June series. This is now available on MCAS and a generic copy of the summer timetable is also available on our website [Summer Exam Timetable 2026](#).

Conduct during the examinations

Candidates must follow the examination rules from the moment they enter the exam room until the moment they have left it, otherwise there is an obligation on the school to notify the exam board, with disqualification being a possible outcome. It is vital that no unauthorised items come into the exam room (including all watches, electronic items and papers). All JCQ information for candidates documents and the warning to candidates poster is on our website [Information for Candidates](#) – please ensure your child is fully aware of this information before their first exam.

Attendance for examinations

Formal written examinations take place 5 May - 15 June, with a contingency day on 24 June (in case of a national emergency during the exam season), which students should be available for. There is an absolute requirement that candidates entered for an examination must attend. If there are any emergencies on the day of an exam, you must telephone the school immediately.

Collecting results, reviews of results, access to scripts and certificates

Results can be collected from the school on Thursday 20 August at 10am. Further details will be available to candidates prior to their first exam. If your child believes there may have been a mistake in any of their grades, they can request access to their script and/or



a review of marking. Further details of these services, fees and dates will be given to candidates and will be included with the results slip. Certificates will be available in November at our annual Presentation Evening.
