Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 9 PPE results

Over the course of the past few weeks students in Year 9 completed short assessment papers in English, Maths and the three Science disciplines; Biology, Chemistry and Physics. On Monday, students have been given their results in an extra-ordinary assembly. A copy of this assembly will be uploaded to Tutor Google Classrooms – please do ask your son/daughter to show you if you wish to see the full content.

Students have been issued a percentage score in each of their papers. Students were assessed on content from across Year 9 and this did not necessarily map to GCSE content – therefore an indicative GCSE grade has not been issued. To help students assess their attainment they have been provided with the average scores for their class too (below).

Where students may feel disappointed with a result, they should use this as a constructive springboard to adjust their focus and engagement as they transition into their GCSE studies.
