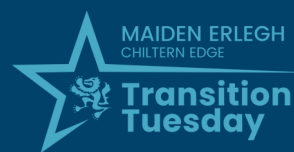


Transition Days

And the Headteacher's Challenge!

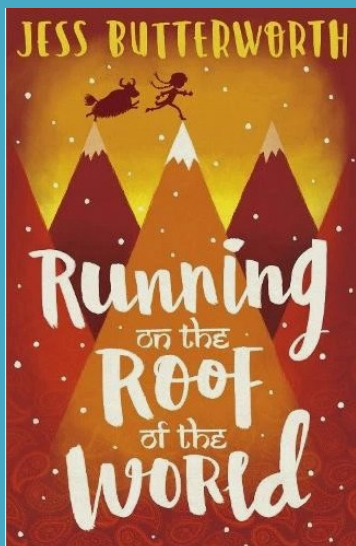
Headteacher's Challenge
