On 16 October our school will celebrate in the worldwide **Restart a Heart (RSAH) Campaign** to raise awareness for cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR). It will be a non-uniform day for all students with a suggested £2 donation going towards the South Central Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust.

As well as raising awareness, students in years 7,8 & 9 have been selected to take part in the Restart a Heart campaign training.

They will be taking part in training provided by our local ambulance service for Restart a Heart day. They will be asked to complete a short questionnaire after the training about their experiences?

The questionnaire will be anonymous, your child will not be identified in any reports or outputs from this study. The questionnaire asks your child:

- Their age group and (optional) gender
- Whether they have had any previous experience of training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) or using an automated defibrillator (AED)
- It will ask how confident your child felt doing CPR and using an AED before training and how confident they feel after training.
- Quality / satisfaction with training They will be asked to rate, on a scale of 1-10 how good they thought training was.

The questionnaire is part of a study to evaluate the RSAH day. It is funded by the Resuscitation Council (UK) and led by researchers at the university of Warwick Medical School.
