This is a free online platform that contains a wide range of learning resources, online lessons and a catalogue of accredited short courses. The platform also provides users with a content that will help them develop life skills and assist well-being.

The BeReady platform helps prepare students for their next step in life, whether they decide to move into the world of work, or onto university.
