Year 11 Mock Exams, November 2020

Year 11 mock exams this year will take place between 2nd and 9th November. Please see next page for the timetable. Please note that the exams will all take place during the normal school day, including students who have additional time, and that lunch will be at 12.35 as usual.

Students will be given their own paper copy of this timetable during tutor time this week. Individual subject teachers will inform students of topics for revision and any subject specific requirements before half term.

Exam Rules

The mock exams are run in exactly the same way as the formal exams in the summer so you should be aware of the JCQ rules, which have been attached on a separate sheet. Failure to follow these rules could lead to disqualification from your overall qualification.

The main points have been highlighted below:

- Normal school uniform must be worn no gloves, scarves, hats, hoodies or coats will be allowed.
- Bags should be left in the designated area outside the exam room.
- You should have all your equipment with you in a clear pencil case/clear food bag. If you need a calculator, you should bring your own and you should leave the cover in your bag.
- Water is allowed in clear bottles but any labels must be removed.
- Phones should be turned off and either left in your bags or put into the clear plastic wallet on your desk and handed in.
- If you wear a watch, you will be asked to remove it and place it on your desk at the start of the exam. Smart watches are treated in the same way as mobile phones and need to be placed in the plastic wallets or left in your bags.
- You must not communicate with any other candidate from the moment you enter the exam room until the time when you are asked to leave.
- You must follow all instructions given to you by the invigilators.

Access Arrangements

Students who have previously agreed access arrangements will be sitting in the training suite. Invigilators will endeavour to start exams as promptly as possible so that students have the opportunity to use all of their extra time. It is vital that students use their access arrangements as the school must keep evidence that these are the student's normal way of working.
